

Crochet Linen stitch wrap



Using a 4mm crochet hook.

Leaving an 5 inch tail, ch 400.

Row 1: sc in 3rd ch from hook, (ch1, skip 1 ch, sc) to end. Turn.

Row 2: ch 2, sc in 1st ch1 sp, (ch1, sc in next ch1 sp) until 1 sc and the ch 2 sp remain. Ch1, sc in ch 2 sp. Turn.

Repeat row 2 until your run out of yarn.

To make the fringe at the edges leave a 3-inch tail of yarn at the beginning and end of each row. Then every few rows tie the tails together.

The version pictured was made using a Cuddlebums rainbow shawl pack – 100g of rainbow gradient, 100g semi solid grey, 100g natural sock yarn. But this pattern is perfect for mini's or using up scraps of yarn
